THREE SEARCH WARRANTS SERVED RESULT IN 4 ARRESTED

Over a two day period members from the Coalinga Police Department executed three search warrants at various locations in the City. The first was served on Tuesday March 27, 2012 when officers of the Coalinga Police Department served a search warrant in the 1100 block of N. California Street on allegations of narcotic activity. Officers contacted and arrested 28 year old Coalinga Resident Sandra Kilinski for possession of narcotics for sales and possession of stolen property. Kilinski was transported to the Coalinga City Jail where she was booked on narcotics and possession of stolen property violations.

The second search warrant was served on Wednesday March 28, 2012 at the Pleasant Valley Pines Apartment Complex. Officer's contacted two male adults and 18 year old Coalinga Resident Nathaniel Corona. During the search warrant a large amount of ammunition, homemade weapons, improvised explosive devices and narcotic paraphernalia were located in the apartment. Upon completion of the search warrant Corona was arrested on weapon charges, narcotic paraphernalia, possession of ammunition and possession of an improvised explosive device. Corona was transported to the Coalinga City Jail where he was booked and later transported to the Fresno County Jail.

The third search warrant was served on Wednesday March 28, 2012 in the 700 block of E. Pleasant Street. During the search 31 year old Coalinga Resident Ramon Ruiz was contacted and arrested on a felony warrant and 3 misdemeanor warrants. Also contacted and arrested was 19 year old Coalinga resident Juan Montes.

Montes was arrested for Possession of a controlled substance for sale and possession of narcotic paraphernalia. Both Ruiz and Montes was transported to the Coalinga City Jail for booking. They were later transported to the Fresno County Jail.
