CAR JACKING RESULTS IN 3 ARRESTS

On Sunday December 23, 2012, at 3:50 a.m., Officers responded to the area of Third and Cedar Street on a report of a vehicle theft. While en route the Officers were informed the vehicle was heading south on Third Street and turned west on Elm Avenue.

The victim reported he was at a party when a subject identified as 20 year old Huron Resident Daniel Luna reached into the victim's pocket at which time the victim pushed Luna away. An ensuing pushing match started and at that time Luna and two other juveniles both from Huron, left the party. The victim realized his keys were gone and approached Luna outside. Luna told the victim he didn't have his keys and pushed the victim to the ground. Luna and a juvenile was seen getting into the victim's vehicle and drove off.

Officers located the vehicle at Fifth and Ivy Street and made a felony car stop. Arrested in the car was Luna and two male juveniles. A female juvenile was detained and later released. Luna was uncooperative with the officers and would not follow instructions and resisted officers. Once the scene was secured, a Field Show up was done and the subjects were positively identified and taken to the police department for booking.

Luna and the two juveniles were arrested for carjacking, theft of a motor vehicle, possession of a stolen vehicle, conspiracy, and gang enhancements. Luna was

transported the Fresno County Jail and the two juveniles were transported to the Fresno County Juvenile Justice Campus.
