“Former Coalinga-Huron Joint Unified School District High School Substitute Teacher Arrested On Various Sexual Misconduct Charges”

On June 26, 2013, Detectives with the Coalinga Police Department arrested Eric Campos after a lengthy four month investigation into sexual misconduct with students.

Campos was formerly employed by the Coalinga Huron Joint Unified School District as a substitute teacher and basketball coach. The sexual misconduct was brought to police attention after one of his former students committed suicide in Bakersfield, California earlier in the year after graduating from high school.

With that information, Detectives with the Coalinga Police Department began a lengthy investigation, interviewing students and staff, which led to Campos' arrest today.

At this time, Campos is being charged with multiple counts of annoying and molesting a minor, distributing harmful matter to a minor with the intent of seduction and having contact with a minor with the intent to commit a sexual offense.

Campos was processed at the Coalinga Police Department and was booked into Fresno County Main Jail.

The names of victims are being withheld at this time due to the nature of this case.
