Dear Coalinga Community,

As I write this update for you this Monday morning, we currently have 13 positive COVID-19 cases in the Coalinga community. Based on the information provided to us, it is believed that 10 of those cases are active and 3 have recovered.

We are aware that we may have had our first COVID-related death over the weekend, but this has not been confirmed with Fresno County.

Should we receive official confirmation, we will let you know.


