Dear Coalinga Community,

As of this morning, we have had 102 (total) positive COVID-19 cases in the Coalinga community and the Huron community has 103.

Saturday, July 18, 2020, is the Coalinga Community Clean Up Event sponsored by Mid Valley Disposal. The event will begin at 6:00am and end at 12:00pm.

Following the Community Clean Up Event, the City has declared the week of July 20 as City Beautification Week.

Beginning July 20, 2020, the first day of City Beautification Week, the City will be out doing maximum enforcement of all Code violations in all areas of the City.

As a reminder, inoperable vehicles must be parked behind a solid 6-foot fence, junk, trash and debris must not be visible from the street or alleyway, alleyways must be free from junk, trash and debris, vehicles can only be parked on improved surfaces (no parking on grass or dirt) and trashcans must not be visible from the street on days other than trash pick up days. For more information on City Codes, please visit the City website to ensure your property is in compliance.

Our next regularly scheduled City Council meeting will be held on Thursday, on July 16, 2020, at 6:00pm via webinar. It is anticipated that the July City Council meeting webinar will be held via Zoom, as a trial, rather than via the existing platform.

City Hall generally remains closed, but citizens are permitted into the lobby and conference room by scheduling an appointment with the appropriate staff members. Masks are required for face to face meetings and appointments.

As always, I encourage all community members to like the official City of Coalinga Facebook page as we continue to post one-way communication informing the community on important matters.

Please continue to avoid large gatherings and help stop the spread of COVID-19 by staying home if you are sick, washing your hands regularly, avoiding touching your face, and consulting with your doctor if you feel ill. The number of positive cases within the Coalinga community continue to grow. Please do your part to help stop the spread.

The City of Coalinga continues to work with West Hills Medical Group, Fresno County Department of Public Health and the Coalinga Area Chamber of Commerce regarding COVID-19 testing locations within the City of Coalinga. Information on the next testing date will be announced soon.
